



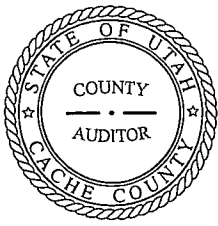

The organization seeks an exemption for personal property which is used to facilitate operation of the Ice Arena classes and programs. The application has been reviewed. The IRS 501 (c) (3) has been included. This organization claims to serve educational purposes. The following are questions requiring some consideration and a hearing should be held before reaching a final determination of exempt status.

- BCIA must show where it should qualify to receive an educational exemption.
- Are fees charged to all? Are there reduced fees based on ability to pay?
- Where is the education? Is it required in the Utah core curriculum?
- Is the public skating free? Are there free instructors?
- Why is this entity different from the Ultimate Sports facility where there is an indoor Soccer field and team leagues and instruction, or the Roller Skating Rink or the Fun Park or the bowling alley?
