Cache County Flooding

We are experiencing numerous instances of flooding throughout Cache County with the amount of rain that has come and with more forecast in the next two days. Many areas including roads have standing and flowing water, and heavy fog is hampering visibility. Please use care and common sense while driving! A car can hydroplane in as little as two inches of water.

Cache County resources are severely depleted and there are not enough personnel to cover all the areas affected by the flooding. If you are experiencing flooding, please use the following contact information for help:

- If you live within the municipal boundaries of a city or town, please contact your city or town hall office for sandbags and/or help with flooding issues.
- Citizens who live in the unincorporated areas of the county can get sandbags at the Cache County Sheriff's Complex, 1225 West 200 North. Phone: 435-755-1000. The sandbags will need to be filled by the individuals taking them.
- If you have flooding concerns on or alongside any county road, contact the Cache County Road Department at: 435-755-1560
- If you have flooding concerns on a State Highway, contact UDOT Region 1 at: 801-620-1600
