Cache County Continues the *Imagine Cache* Planning Process with Community Choices

Join the Conversation to Identify the Direction and Policy Choices for the County's Future

LOGAN, Utah – Cache County is working on the first update to its General Plan in 23 years, and with your input, the General Plan Update will help shape the next 20 years for Cache County. Included in the County's planning process, *Imagine Cache*, the planning team is asking for the public to help resolve conflicting priorities and define a desired policy direction for the County.

County residents, business owners, and regional stakeholders are invited to join the planning team at a Public Meeting and topic-specific Focus Group Workshops at the dates and locations below. Imagine Cache is the integrated planning process for the General Plan Update and the development of a Regional Collaboration Plan, Urban and Rural Areas Assessment, and a Cost of Services Plan. Together these plans will establish a community-supported vision for the next 20 years, and a roadmap to implement that vision.

1. The Cache County General Plan update is a guidance document that steers the County in a desired direction. The General Plan contains the elements that the state mandates all communities address including Land Use, Transportation, and a Moderate Income Housing Plan. This lays out the vision, goals, and policies for the next twenty (20) years guiding land use and policy decisions, as well as goals and implementation techniques. The General Plan will be tied closely



with the Urban and Rural Areas Assessment, Cost of Services Plan, and the Regional Coordination Plan to ensure consistency and to inform opportunities for different focus areas.

2. The Urban and Rural Areas Assessment will identify existing and future growth patterns and focus on services such as Fire, EMS, Law Enforcement, Sewer, Water, and Roads. It will determine where the County can most efficiently serve, promote resilient land use patterns.
3. The coordinating Cost of Services Plan will identify the fiscal impacts of our land use decisions determined in the Urban and Rural Areas Plan.
4. The Regional Collaboration plan will focus on improving and establishing communication and involvement protocols on a regional basis, while developing strategies for service-based growth. This plan will seek to develop a regional communication plan and develop strategies for valley-wide growth that ties the location of growth to the location of services.
