- 3. US Airforce Emergency Management:** Langhus, Meier and Duller review information about composite fibers. The presentation and handouts contained information on the following:

4. Round Table:

- a. GE Health Care:** Bastin indicated that sometime I the next year the GE Health Care facility in the valley will be holding an emergency drill and he would like to coordinate with local responders to help with the drill.
- b. US Airforce Emergency Management:** Presenters introduced themselves and indicated that they would like to help the local group any way they can if needed.
- c. State CERT:** Spendlove announced that a county wide emergency preparedness fair will be held at Green Canyon High School on 7 Oct 2017. Flyers were available contact Spendlove for more information.
- d. State of Utah Department of Emergency Services:** Giles reported that new rules were covered at the LEP Conference. Giles shared the website which is <http://www.dem.ut.gov>. She reminded the group to check there for upcoming events and training opportunities posted on the site.

The state is concerned about communities being prepared for extreme weather situations as they seem to be happening more frequently. She encouraged all present to go back to their organizations a plan for emergency situations and ask for the funding to be staffed and prepared. The state of UT is working on a rainy day fund which can be used to help with costed associated with emergency situations, but local entities need to plan and prepare on their own as well.
- e. EPA Region 8:** Broussard introduced herself as the Risk Management Plan Coordinator and shared that she is part of the Denver unit. She was in the area and wanted to attend a local meeting; she indicated that the unit she belongs to does not have any enforcement authority, but is tasked compliance assistance and LEPC assistance. The unit can do Computer Aided Management of Emergency Operations (CAMEO) training can also plum modeling software training. The training is free and go up to as long as three days. They also have canned table top training exercise.

They can help local industry with half day events and involve OSHA and the Department of Homeland Security.

She provided a handout that included contact, training and resource information and encouraged the group to use them as a resource.
